When is payment due? How do I pay?

Payment is due on the first lesson of every month. We do not charge late fees. Right now we accept cash, check, and paypal. Refer to www.redberrymusic.com for current tuition/rates.

What if I'm sick or can't make the lesson?

I do everything I can to be flexible and reschedule missed lessons. Please try to give more than 24 hours notice if you'll be missing your lesson and we can try to do a makeup lesson that week.

During inclement weather, if Baltimore County schools are closed there are no lessons that day and I will offer a time for makeup lessons.

What is the monthly lesson schedule?

Each student is given a 30-minute lesson in a specific time slot each week. Please arrive a few minutes before your lesson begins so that we can get started and maximize the full 30 minutes.

Tuition is the same whether there are 3, 4, or 5 lessons that month. *We do not* offer individual lessons, only monthly.

Teacher Absence

If the teacher is unable to make the lesson due to sickness, emergency, etc. either a substitute instructor will perform the lesson OR a makeup lesson will be scheduled.

Canceling Lessons

You may cancel lessons at any time for any reason. There are no contracts here at Redberry. However, tuition is not refundable.
